NWTC – Is under major construction and is having a problem with Door county not wanting to be in their tax base.

A motion was made to have MATC – Milwaukee to host the website. Approved 7-0-0.

The amendment was approved 7-0-0.

The motion was approved 6-1-0.

It was motion and seconded to raise the printing budget to \$400. It was approved 7-0-0.

It was motion and seconded to leave the decoration/entertainment budget at \$495. It was approved 7-0-0.

It was motioned and seconded that the business card format be sent to each advisor and each school print up the business card for each student attending. It was approved 7-0-0.

It was motioned and seconded to have the t-shirt/button budget at \$800.

It was motioned and seconded to amend the name to the accessory committee. It was approved 6-0-1. The budget motion was approve 7-0-0.

It was motioned and seconded to empower the executive committee to approve amend budgets as needed. It was approve 7-0-0.
